Welcome to the October edition of our newsletter, bringing you the latest updates from the AIROPLANE Trial.


This month we are extending a warm welcome to another New South Wales site, Campbelltown Hopital, where Dr. Kalpesh Jain has agreed to lead the team there.

### **UPDATES & ANNOUNCEMENTS**



Transfer Data Entry has now been updated to include questions about the respiratory and oxygen support the infant received during their stay in your hospital and at the time of transfer. This means there will no longer be a need to contact other sites for information about treatments the infant received at other hospitals, & instead the discharge questions relate only to your site. We hope this update will make the discharge data entry an easier process for all sites.

The CRF Completion Guidelines have

been updated and circulated.
We ask that Site Leads ensure their staff are made aware of this update.

#### **PROTOCOL DEVIATIONS**

Last month we asked that teams focus on the need to remain in the allocated oxygen concentration for the FULL 3 MINUTES unless HR<60 or ETT needed so we keep protocol deviations down and we are pleased to report there has been a drop in these minor deviations. In addition, we only saw one major deviation last month where treatment was commenced in the wrong concentration. Welldone to all teams. Let's keep this trend going!
